Hello,

Homeland Security Presidential Directive #5 calls for a single, comprehensive National Incident Management System (NIMS) for managing all emergency events. All preparedness funds passed through from the national level are contingent upon compliance with NIMS. A reporting tool has been designed for healthcare organizations receiving funding from the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR) grant through the Washington State Department of Health (DOH), and includes only those NIMS elements that are required for healthcare organizations.

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When considering the training requirements, keep in mind there is no magic number or percentage of people who need to be trained. A careful review of your organizations response plan, clear definition of the roles to be filled under the response plan, and an understanding of how your organization will work with community partners during a response will help you determine what level of training each employee should complete.
